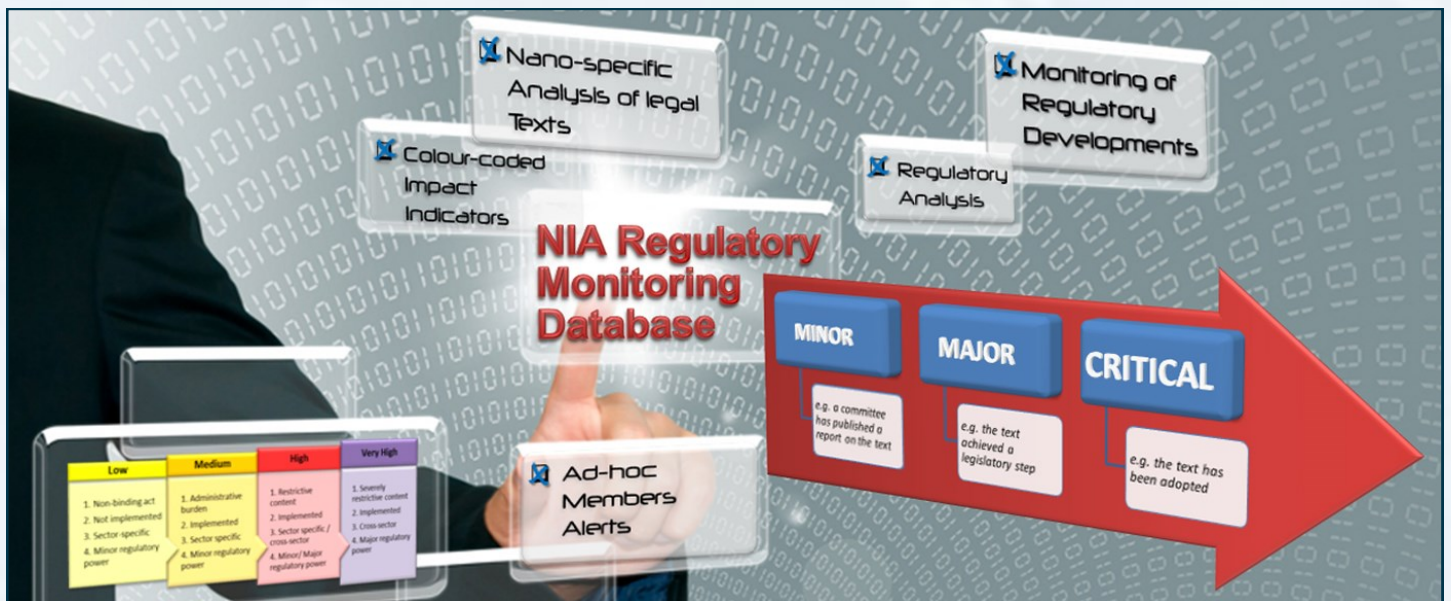

- Legislative documents pertaining to nanotechnology and policy documents with nano-specific provisions are listed and analysed in the NIA Regulatory Monitoring Database.
- NIA provides updated Analysis Pages with key information on the documents in the Database.
- NIA keeps track of the history of regulatory developments, letting users know the latest news as soon as it breaks.
- Users are alerted to updates in the regulatory process.
- The NIA Regulatory Monitoring Database also acts as repository for NIA Publications (briefings, opinions, news articles, etc.) on targeted regulatory documents.
- Analysis Pages are available in a printer-friendly format that allow users to easily extract and carry around key information on policy documents dealing with nanotechnology.

In-depth & easy-to-read analysis of Policy Documents

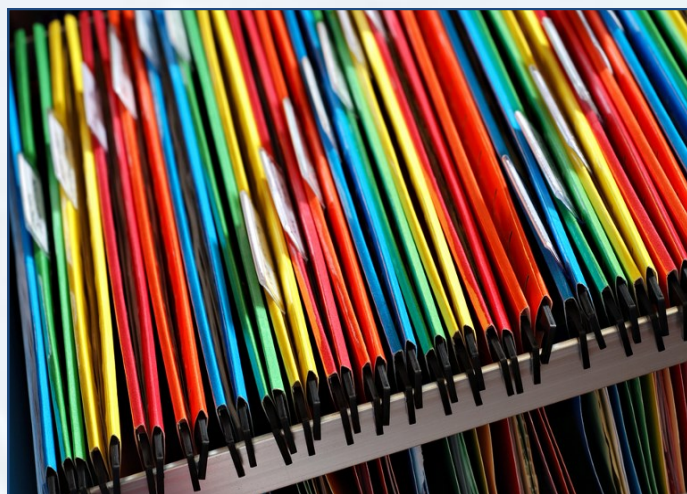
The NIA Regulatory Monitoring Database provides all the information available on any particular document, thereby providing a complete overview.

Individual Analysis Pages provide an updated outlook of the nano-specific requirements dictated by a given act. These pages gather information about the text, such as key actors and main dates, and also list the nano-relevant quotes from the legislative document. Related NIA publications, the text of the act and useful links are also given.

Regulations, standards, guidance and other policy documents have been **listed, prioritised and analysed** by NIA, with a set of colour-coded impact indicators which allows for a better and quicker understanding of the policies. Each individual document has been scrutinised on pages where additional useful information for businesses working with nanotechnology can be found.
